WFPI September Update:

Because we did not have a quorum on September 6th, staff members aggregated a written update from leadership covering the planned agenda items. Please note *Action* items and respond by email.

• Committee Updates

- <u>Outreach</u> Dr Cicero Silva reports for the month of August:
 - 11 tele cases
 - Dr Wootton from *Collegium Telemedicus* wrote gauging my interest on writing a manuscript on WFPI teleradiology. I'm waiting to hear more details, shall share with the Council when received.
- <u>MRI Protocol</u> Dr. Michael Gee No update provided.
- Digital Education Committee (Website Update) Dr. Sanjay Prabhu reports that he is working with staff to make stylistic and content updates. When the streamlining process is complete a meeting of the Digital Ambassadors will be organized.
- <u>TB</u> Dr. Kushaljit Singh Sodhi No update provided.

Observership update – Dr. Jaishree Naidoo reports that the observership went very well. Unfortunately Dr. Akinmoladun's husband fell ill and was admitted to hospital. Therefore she returned to Nigeria this past weekend. She reported upon her return home that her husband is improving. Although there were 3 weeks remaining to complete the planned term, Dr. Naidoo expressed confidence that they covered a great deal during Dr. Akinmoladun's time in South Africa and, most importantly, they will continue to collaborate and share protocols.

Apart from the previously reported IDOR case report, Dr. Akinmoladun is also working on a review article Coarctation of the Aorta as she saw a few cases during her time at NMCH and spent time with the cardiologist and CT surgeon to get more insight on the clinical aspects.

Dr. Naidoo has asked Dr. Akinmoladun to provide a report of her visit in SA when she and her family are more settled.

- WFPI/ Bill Shiels Foundation scholarships in Latin America and Egypt: Dr. Boechat reports that there is a delay in preparing the letters because the agreement with the BSF has not been finalized yet, although there is progress towards that goal. Dr. Boechat reports that she will draft letters to Drs. Jose Lipsich (Buenos Aires, Argentina) and Khaled Ahmad (Cairo, Egypt), once it is clear what the content should be.
 - ACTION: Once the details of the scholarships are final, Dr. Boechat will finalize and send the letters, cosigned by Drs. Lam and Atalabi.
- Alianza LatinSafe As a member of the LatinSafe Board, representing the WFPI, Dr. Boechat received a letter from Dr. Hilton Leao Filho, LatinSafe President, summarizing their recent developments:
 - The Latinsafe website location has been migrated to Brazil, where he lives, in order to facilitate dynamics of management and updates; this was done with the consent of the Colegio Interamericano de Radiologia (CIR).
 - A contract was signed with a company to provide Secretary and Communication services, in order to better connect the supporting organizations and collaborators;
 - Technical update of the website is being performed
 - He asked Dr. Boechat to update the WFPI Council on these new developments and requested permission to use the WFPI logo as a supporting organization in their website

- Mapping project Dr. Ines Boechat reports that she has not been able to contact Dr. Gloria Soto; sent her several messages, without answer. At this point, Dr. Boechat is unsure how to proceed on the manuscript and would appreciate input from the EC.
- Image Gently in Brazil Dr. Ines Boechat reports that Dr. Dolores Bustelo, a well-known Brazilian Pediatric Radiologist, has worked with the Brazilian Academy of Pediatrics, on a campaign to disseminate information about Image Gently in Brazil. She has the support of several other medical organizations in Brazil, including the Colegio Brasileiro de Radiologia. She would like to add the WFPI logo in their website and documents, as a supporting organization. She has also asked Dr. Boechat to review several documents she is preparing, to be disseminated to those who care for the more than 35.000,000 children in Brazil.
